	Obstacle	Directives	Points	Remarks
1	Railroad Crossing	Walk quietly over the RR crossing. Proceed to next obstacle at a walk		
2	L Shaped varied Footing	Enter L shaped lane with various footing options which can include pine straw, Spanish Moss, shavings etc. at a walk. Before leaving L halt at red line		
3	Back	Back 4-5 Steps keeping horse straight through 2 nd half of varied footing. Then proceed at walk .		
4	Ring Bell	Halt 5 seconds. Ring bell. Proceed at trot to next obstacle.		
5	One Handed Figure 8	Approaching gate marked by cones gather reins in one hand. Pass through gate and begin Figure 8 around poles one handed. After passing through the cone gate again return reins to 2 hands. Proceed to next obstacle at the trot.		
6	Water Crossing	Approaching water transition to the walk. Enter water between 2 cone markers. Proceed through water at a walk and exit through 2 nd set of cone markers . Proceed to next obstacle at a trot.		
7	Bean Bag Toss	Approaching obstacle transition to a walk. Halt at muck bucket. Toss bean bag given to you at beginning of trail course into muck bucket while horse stands immobile. Exit course at walk.
